Dear Parents/Carers,

We thank you for all your feedback in our Parent Survey in the Spring Term. We have carefully considered all the points you have made and have already made changes when/where possible. Please see below our 'you said... we did...' table, in response to your suggestions and comments.

You said	We did
Too many pupil leadership groups so responsibilities are spread too thinly.	Reduced the number of pupil leadership groups to Eco- Warriors, School Council, Spiritual Committee, Team Captains and Heads of Pupil Leadership (formerly Head Boy and Head Girl)
Improve communication about changes and development in school.	Set up parent champion meetings that will run throughout 2022 and 2023 to discuss key areas of school life and curriculum.
Bring back enrichment afternoons.	This will return in September 2022, but will look slightly different. We will also be running Children's University alongside this. Further details to follow.
More opportunities for forest school.	Miss Gough has now completed her Forest School Training and will begin forest school in September – this will be called Woodland School. Further details to follow.
A sports coach to teach PE and Sports is missing.	We will be utilising our Sports Premium money to employ sports coaches through Aston Villa and Progressive Sports. All children will be able to access some of this throughout the school week.
Would like extra-curricular clubs for Reception, which run until 4:15.	Reception will have an extra-curricular offer, which will begin in Autumn 2. Further details to follow.
More after school clubs, particularly sports and more competitive sport.	Aston Villa and Progressive Sports will be running after school clubs 3 days per week and during lunchtime from September. Teachers will also be running sports clubs. Miss Gough and Mrs. Brown will be running 'competitive sports clubs' so that our children can be involved in local school competitions. Further details to follow.

More opportunities for parents/carers to be in school.	Held Careers And Ambitions Week, Times Table Rockstars Workshop (Y4) and Sports Day in Summer 2022. We will be sending out further information about opportunities for you to be in school and take part in messy church, showcases of children's work, book sharing and workshops. Further details to follow.
All children have access to the same curriculum offer and opportunities.	Lighthouse provision will no longer be functioning in the same way as previously. All children will be taught within their main classroom for the duration of the day (Y3 will look slightly different). LSAs have been re-deployed to improve support and provision in afternoons for all children in school. We now have 3 members of staff who will be ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) trained September 2022. We now have a SENDCo Lead from ATLP (Michelle Spires), who has a wealth of experience and expertise to support our SEND pupils and parents. Mrs. Bee will return in November 2022 and will work alongside Mrs. Spires.
Improve communication about curriculum and topics.	A year group overview will be sent home before September 2022. There will also be more detailed curriculum overviews sent at the start of each half term.
More support for transition to new year groups.	More opportunities for children to meet and find out about their new teachers through story times and letters, in addition to the transition days.

We look forward to talking to you in our parent champion meetings over next academic year, we will also send another survey to check in with you in 2023.
