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Our St Chad’s uniform unites us in our community and provides a sense of belonging for our children. It is part of celebrating who we are and showing the pride we have in our school.

We have designed our uniform to be inclusive of all genders and pronoun choices or identification. In line with this, we do not stipulate that children must wear specifically male or female items, except for swimming.

Jumpers, cardigans, fleeces, PE t-shirts and polo shirts can all be purchased with the school logo on from our local uniform supplies. However, it is **not mandatory** to purchase from our school supplier with the logo, instead children can wear **plain** versions of the clothing.

Outdoor PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Royal blue or white t-shirt (plain or with school logo) • Plain black sweatshirt OR plain black zip up hoodie • Plain black jogging trousers OR leggings • Trainers • NO sports/football shirts
Swimming	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Girls: One piece swimming costume • Boys: Swimming trunks (not shorts) • Swimming hat • Prescription goggles, if needed
Jewellery / Make Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 pair of stud earrings • 1 watch (no smart watches which can take photographs) • No make-up / false nails / painted nails • Hair should be worn up if longer than shoulders • No rings, bracelets or necklaces
Optional Extras	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School logo water bottle • School logo book bag • School logo PE bag (if carrying kit for extra curricular activity) • School logo royal blue fleece (for outside use only)

*Ties can be removed in the summer if hot.

**School shoes should not be fashion boots, flip flops, open toe sandals, heeled shoes or trainers.
